

BASES:

1. Maximum number of participant teams is 80, with 4 pigeons each.

2. Team Inscription cost (4 pigeons by team) is 7500 points.*

Last date for inscription register is March 31st, 2010.

In order to respect its pre-inscription, an advance payment of 2000 points is required.

3. The pigeons will not be passed to the flight loft without 100% of the Inscription payment.

4. Participant pigeons will be able to carry ring of year 2010, from any National or International Association or Organism.

5. All pigeons will be training in a unique loft. "Palomar de la Isla San Marcos"

6. The pigeons will be received solely during March 2010. Replacements for lost or ill pigeons will be until April 30th 2010.

7. The flights will be realize in the modality of Triple Crown including the following competitions:

- **Ace Pigeon** (The pigeon with best individual score). Pigeons add points if they classified within 33% from total pigeons sent on each of race.

- **Best Team** (The team with best score). Teams add the points on each race coming from the first two classified pigeons.

- **Final flight** (420 km). Individual prizes for the first 10 places.

8. The score system used will be the same to one used in by International Pigeon Federation. Base on 1000 points for the winner on each race.

9. Date and distances for the 3 races with points will be as follow:

- Jul 31st / 230Kms (143 miles approx.)

- Aug 7th / 330 km (205 miles approx.)

- Aug 14th / 430 km (268 miles approx.)

10. If 2 or more pigeons arrive together, they will have same place in official race list and corresponding prizes will be added and split in equal parts.

11. Poles will be distributed according to the marks registered by the clock.

12. If misfortunes in the schedule of the release do not exist, maximum time limit for scoring on each flight will be the 12:00 hours of the following day to the liberation.

13. In case of missing prizes after established time for the race, those will be added and proportional distributed between received pigeons.

14. In the case of no pigeons received in the established time, the prizes will be distributed between the sent pigeons. For Ace pigeon and Best Team competitions those will be award base on previous cumulated points.

PRIZES for all the competitions will consist in the 75% of the total of the inscriptions, distributed in the following proportions:
